art room

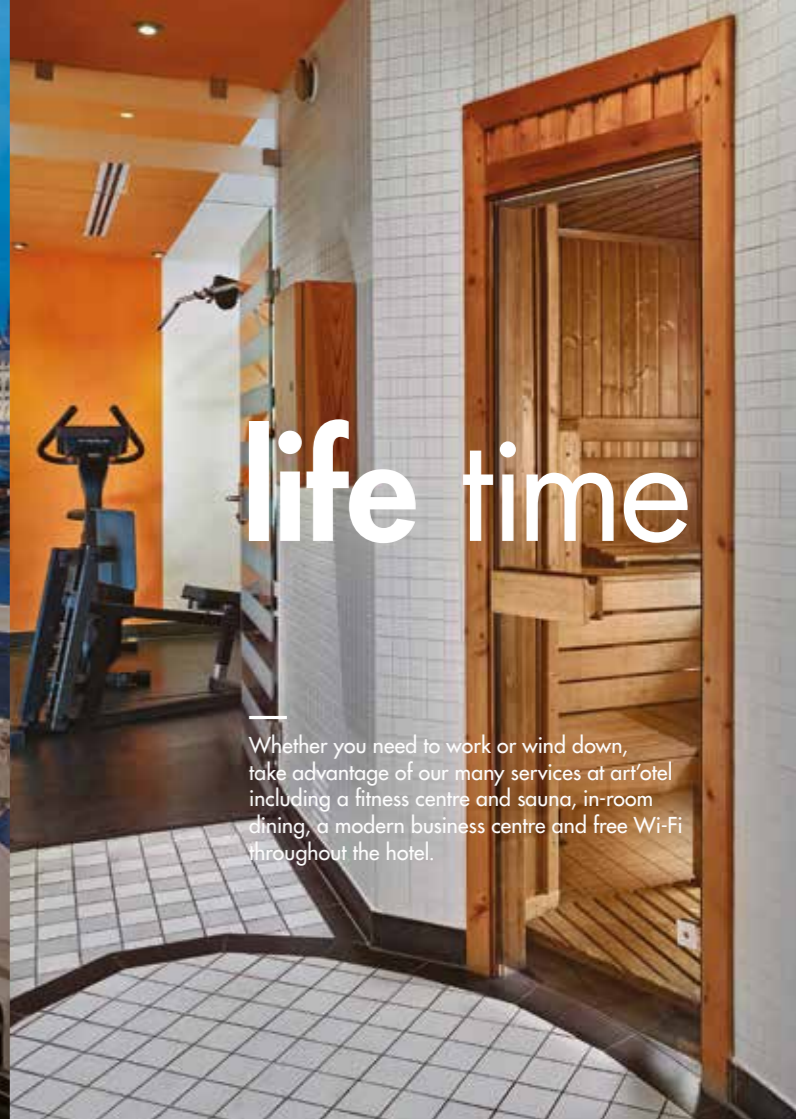

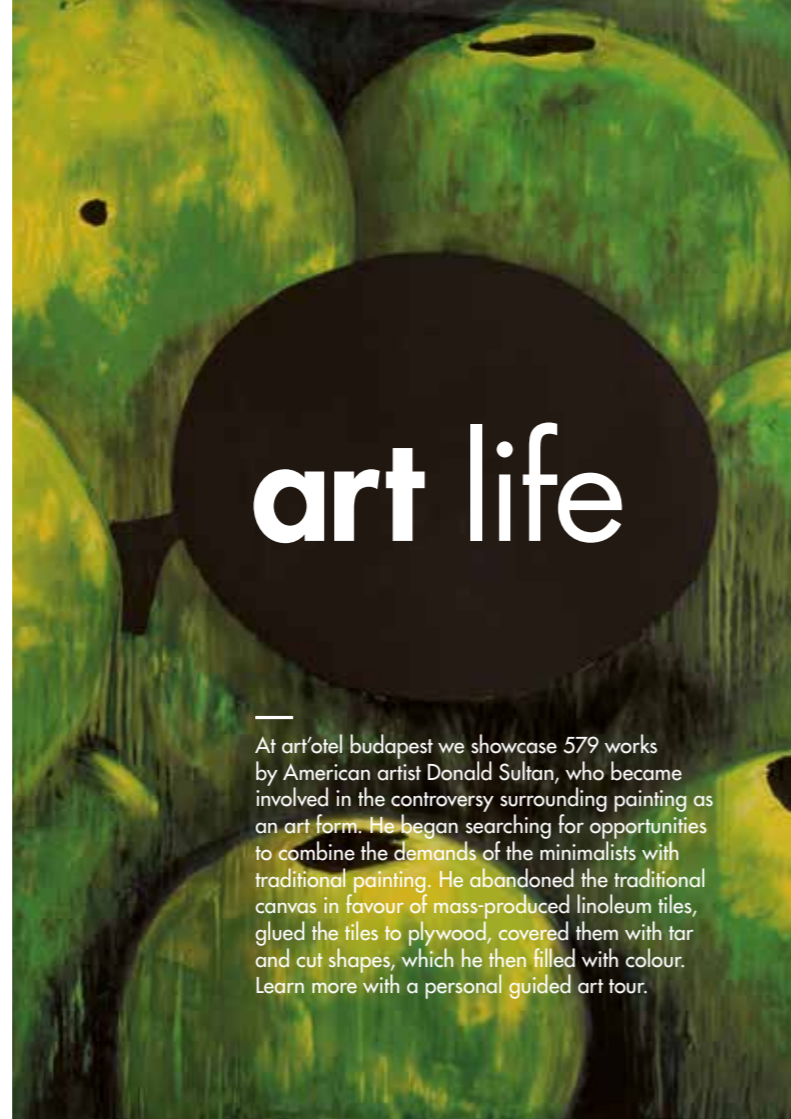

At artotel budapest we showcase 579 works by American artist Donald Sultan, who became involved in the controversy surrounding painting as an art form. He began searching for opportunities to combine the demands of the minimalists with traditional painting. He abandoned the traditional canvas in favour of mass-produced linoleum tiles, glued the tiles to plywood, covered them with tar and cut shapes, which he then filled with colour. Our flexible event space can be configured to host functions for between 10 and 180 delegates. Our 150m² Tapestry Room can be divided into three areas with soundproofed mobile walls while our intimate Garden Room can host 15 guests classroom style or 30 theatre style, and can combine with the River Room for larger events. Our Domino Room has majestic views across the Danube towards the parliament building, while our smaller rooms are ideal for board meetings and private gatherings.
